Plenary Indulgence during Christmas Season

The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has granted the privilege of a plenary indulgence for all the faithful to celebrate the 800th anniversary of Christmas in Greccio, Italy. The indulgence is available, under the usual conditions, from 8 December 2023, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, to 2 February 2024, Feast of the Presentation in the Temple of Our Lord Jesus Christ. In order to gain the plenary indulgence, in addition to the usual conditions one must visit a church run by the Franciscan families throughout the world and stop in prayer in front of the nativity scene set up there. Those who are sick or unable to participate physically can equally benefit from the gift of the plenary indulgence by offering their sufferings to the Lord or carrying out practices of piety. In the Diocese of Columbus, Christ the King Parish and St. Thomas parish are run by Franciscans.
