The Catholic Mass is the most powerful form of prayer, & its common practice to have it offered for a specific intention. While Mass Intentions can be requested on behalf of a living person, for ex: the healing of someone who is sick or to commemorate a wedding anniversary, they're more commonly offered in remembrance of a person who has died. We offer Masses for our deceased loved ones to aid them in their journey to heaven. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "From the beginning, the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the **Eucharistic sacrifice**, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God." (CCC 1032). The Mass unites the Church on earth with the Church in heaven. The intentions of the Mass are lifted by the Body of Christ in its entirety. See "**Mass Intentions**" instructions.
